RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair International. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes. Heifer calves shown on the side of the Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Females will not be eligible to show in the heifer calf classes. The heifer calf entry fee will not be refunded.
3. The CHAROLAIS Futurity is open to all calendar year heifer calves (born in 2016) with a no charge entry fee.
4. The Charolais Heifer Futurity Champion will receive a prize of \$1,000 and Reserve Champion will receive \$500 which is sponsored by the ALBERTA CHAROLAIS ASSOC.
