***Classes will be broken down by calving date. Prize money is based on two (2) splits of pen of 5's and 10's. At show Management's discretion more or less splits may be made and Prize money within will be allocated within the splits.**

RULES & REGULATIONS

- All entries are subject to Farmfair International General Rules and Regulations. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
- All entries into the Bred Heifer Show have to sell in the sale.
- Any disputes on entry to sale will be reviewed by a selection committee consisting of two sale management representatives and one outside industry representative.
- All heifers need to be pregnancy checked prior to arrival in The Yards at Northlands. Heifers must be accompanied with a pregnancy certificate from a licensed veterinarian. Pregnancy checks must not be conducted no more than 15 days prior to the show and sale.
- Bred Heifers will be shown in their natural condition. Animals entered into the show and sale may be washed and brushed prior to arriving at Northlands. **No clipping, burning of hair or any other form of show preparation will be allowed on commercial heifers.** Any evidence of above practices may cause entries to be disqualified.
- Northlands will bed, feed and water the pens of heifers on the 11th, 12th and 13th. If contributor wishes to assist they are more than welcome but are not required.
- Animals do not need to be halter broken; they will be stabled and shown in pens.
- Animals will run through a ring to be shown and sold. Exhibitors can assist in getting cattle to the ring for the show but are not required to assist.
- One industry judge will be selected to judge the show and award places to the top three pens in each class (based on calving date) and select the overall Champion & Reserve Champion Pens.
- The People's Choice component will be judged by the public. Each individual can enter on placing a ballot. Each ballot will place the top three pens in the show. Based on the People's Choice ballots the top three pens will be awarded as People's Choice Champions.



11. Sale will be broadcast on DLMS and all catalogue information will be posted on DLMS prior to the event for review by exhibitor and for marketing of sale pens.
12. Exhibitors will be allowed to put up a farm/stall signs in front of pen(s) to provide information about cattle offered in show and sale.
13. Show and Sale Management reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the above rules and to interpret these rules and to make changes as required for the proper operation of the show and sale.
