- 2. Showmanship

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair.
- 2. Parent participation is not allowed with the exception of exhibitor and/or public safety. Adults will not be allowed to assist with the preparation of animals. Juniors are encouraged to assist other juniors. During registration junior exhibitors have the option to sign up to be partnered with a senior member to receive help during the competition. Exhibitors in violation of this rule will be disqualified from the show.
- 3. The show committee reserves the right to make decisions on any point not covered by these rules and to make corrections as necessary.

1. All Breeds Conformation Show

- 1. Animal must be exhibited by the junior named on the entry form.
- 2. Animals must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or farm corporations that the junior is a member of, however the junior exhibitor must be named on the entry form.
- 3. Animals registered jointly by two juniors may only be exhibited by one. If an animal is jointly owned by a junior and non-junior, it must be shown in the Open Division.
- 4. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Animals may be entered in a maximum of one class. **No cross entries between divisions**, except for 2016 calendar year calves and Pee Wee Division animals. *NEW
- 5. Animals shown in the Pee Wee divisions are eligible to be shown by another junior in a different division, provided the animal qualifies.
- 6. Calendar year calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in their respective class. In the event that both would qualify to advance only one animal unit can advance.
- 7. Champions from the Open and Bred & Owned will qualify for the Junior Futurity Championship Final. Pee Wee and Commercial champions are not eligible to compete in the Championship final.
- 8. Proof of registration is required for the Open and Bred & Owned Divisions and is to be presented at the time of registration on Thursday, November 10th. Animals without registration papers will not be eligible to show in the Open or Bred & Owned divisions.
- 9. An animal may be asked to leave the show ring at the discretion of the Junior Show committee.
- 10. All grooming must be done by JUNIORS ONLY. Juniors may assist one another.
- 11. Classes will be split by age of animal if warranted after entries close at the discretion of the committee.
- 12. Pee Wee exhibitors are not allowed to show in the Open, Bred & Owned or Commercial Divisions. Must be nine years of age to exhibit in those divisions.





Pee Wee Show - Wednesday 9th, 11:30 a.m.

Animals entered in the Pee Wee Division must be exhibited by a junior between the ages of five to eight; animals shown in the Pee Wee division are eligible to be shown by a different junior in the other divisions if they meet the criteria.

- 2. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
- 3. Yearling Heifer: Born in 2015
- 4. Champion & Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer
- 5. Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2016
- 6. Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
- 7. Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Pee Wee Division
- 8. Showmanship

Bred & Owned Show - Thursday 10th 5pm

Animals entered in the Bred & Owned Division must be accompanied by registration papers that show the exhibitor as the sole breeder of the animal and sole or joint owner of the entry. Ownership must be declared at time of entry. To qualify for the Bred and Owned division, the exhibitor must provide the registration papers of both the entry and its dam by Oct 1st 2016. If papers are not provided, entry will be scratched and not allowed to enter any other class.

Commercial Show - Friday 11th 4pm

Animals entered in the Commercial Division may not be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Animals may be of any percentage.

- 17. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
- 18. Yearling Heifer: Born in 2015
- 19. Champion & Reserve Champion Junior Female
- 20. Two-Year-Old Heifer: Born in 2014, with her own 2016 natural, tattooed calf at foot
- 21. Mature Cow: Born prior to 2014 with her own 2016, natural tattooed calf at foot
- 22. Champion & Reserve Champion Senior Female
- 23. Champions & Reserve Champion Commercial Division





Open Show - Saturday 12th 9am

Animals entered in the Open Division may not be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Registration papers are required.

- 24. Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2016
- 25. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
- 26. Yearling Heifer: Born in 2015
- 27. Champion & reserve Champion Junior Female
- 28. Two-Year-Old Heifer: Born in 2014 with her own 2016 natural, tattooed calf at foot
- 29. Mature Cow: Born prior to 2014 with her own 2016, natural, tattooed calf at foot
- 30. Champion & Reserve Champion Senior Female
- 31. Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2016
- 32. Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
- 33. Champion & Reserve Champion Open Junior Division

Alberta Junior Futurity Supreme Show - following Open Show

34. Overall Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Junior Futurity Entry (Champions from class 17, and 24 advance to the championship classes)

The Overall Grand Champion of the Junior Futurity All Breeds Show will qualify for the Alberta Supreme show.

2. Showmanship - following Open Show

- This competition will be judged as a stand-alone event.
 The animal shown does not have to be owned by the exhibitor if participating in showmanship specific classes.
- All junior exhibitors are eligible to compete in the showmanship competition. Those juniors who are not exhibiting
 cattle at Farmfair will be paired up with a breeder to use one of their animals for the competition and will compete
 in a separate class prior to the Showmanship championship class in order to qualify for the championship.
