RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair International. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes.
3. The CHAROLAIS Futurity is open to all calendar year heifer and bull calves (born in 2017) and will be selected during the show during the Heifer Calf and Bull Calf Championship classes. No additional entry fee is charged and every calf entered in the Heifer and Bull calf classes is eligible. Calves on the side of cows must be entered into either the individual Bull Calf or Heifer Calf class additionally to be eligible for the Futurity.
4. The Charolais Bull calf and Heifer calf Futurity Champion will receive a prize of \$1,000 and Reserve Champion will receive \$500 which is sponsored by the ALBERTA CHAROLAIS ASSOC.
5. Show harnesses will be mandatory in the show ring.

Alberta Charolais Association is sponsoring a Charolais Influenced steer and heifer class as part of the 2017 Prospect Steer and Heifer Show. Champion Charolais Influenced steer and heifer will each receive \$500 and reserve will each receive \$250. The ACA Board of Directors will hold the final decision as to whether the calves are distinguishable as Charolais influenced. All cattle entered in these two classes will HAVE to be stalled in the Charolais stalling area. No animals stalled outside Charolais area will be eligible to show in these two classes.
