RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair International. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes.
3. The Pair of Heifer Calves class is open to all calendar year heifer calves. All heifer calves entered in the Pair of Heifer Calves must also be entered in the 2018 National Charolais Show Heifer Calf Class (Class 2) to be eligible to compete for a prize of \$10,000. To be eligible both heifer calves must be from the same breeding operation and/or family operation.
4. Charolais Bull Calves entered in the "Players Club" Elite Breeder's Bull Calf Futurity on November 8th must also be entered in the 2018 National Charolais Show Bull Calf Class (Class 11).
5. **Show harnesses will be mandatory in the show ring.**

Champion Charolais Influenced steer and heifer will each receive \$500 and Reserve will each receive \$250. The ACA Board of Directors will hold the final decision as to whether the calves are distinguishable as Charolais influenced. All cattle entered in these two classes will HAVE to be stalled in the Charolais stalling area. No animals stalled outside Charolais area will be eligible to show in these two classes.
