



## Northlands Barrel Racing Futurity Rules

1. All riders are required to be in western attire during competition; jeans, western boots, cowboy hat, button up shirt with cuff and collar.
2. Saddle pad numbers must be visible at all times of the competition.
3. Random drug testing will be done, and will be tested in accordance with the WPRA Drug Policy - <http://www.wpra.com/>
4. Open to any horse 5 years and younger and is futurity eligible (not competed on prior to Dec 1st 2016.) Futurity will be TWO go rounds and an average. Champions will be declared on a TWO run average.
5. Entry Deadline:  
Payments: \$275.00 received by October 1, 2017  
All late entries (received after October 1, 2017 and before November 1, 2017) will be subject to a \$100 Late Fee.
7. Cheques to be made payable to Northlands.
8. Entry substitutions will be accepted for death, illness or unsoundness up until November 4, 2018. Veterinarian affidavit of proof must accompany substitutions' along with a \$25.00 fee. A substitution of Rider is allowed and free provided the office is notified prior to 1st go.
9. NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON.
10. A maximum of three gate call will be given, after which the horse and rider combination will be disqualified for that go- round.
12. 45 gallon barrels, having both ends will be used.
13. A tipped barrel will result in a no time
14. There will be NO reruns given if a horse falls, is pulled up by the rider or due to malfunction of contestant's equipment.
15. Not following the clover-leaf pattern will result in a no time. A broken pattern shall be defined as breaking the forward motion to retrace the tracks to finish the pattern or making more than the three turns of the clover-leaf pattern or crossing the finish line prior to completion of the run. If a contestant runs by a barrel and has to back up or turn around and retrace their tracks, this would be considered a broken pattern. There shall be no circling of barrels and the run shall be completed at race speed or remove yourself from arena. Failure to do so will result in a no time and your other run will be disqualified.

16. In the event of a tie in the average prize money will be divided equally, the prizes will go to the rider in the tie with the fastest individual time.
  17. Any questions or dispute which may arise during the course of the Event not covered by the above rules will be decided by the Northlands Event Coordinator and the Northlands Barrel Racing Futurity Committee.
  18. Pay Out:  
1st and 2nd Go -30% of total prize money  
Average - 40 % of total prize money  
6 monies in each go and average
  19. Prize payout will be to the owner of the horse unless specified on Entry Forms.
