 ** Junior exhibitors must pay the Showmanship Fee to be entered into the competition.
 *** Tie out fee does not need to be paid if junior entries are also entered into the open breed shows.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair.
2. Parent participation is not allowed with the exception of exhibitor and/or public safety. Adults will not be allowed to assist with the preparation of animals. Juniors are encouraged to assist other juniors. During registration junior exhibitors have the option to sign up to be partnered with a senior member to receive help during the competition. Exhibitors in violation of this rule will be disqualified from the show.
3. The show committee reserves the right to make decisions on any point not covered by these rules and to make corrections as necessary.
4. Show harnesses will be mandatory in the show ring.

All Breeds Conformation Show

1. Animal must be exhibited by the junior named on the entry form.
2. Animals must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or farm corporations that the junior is a member of, however the junior exhibitor must be named on the entry form.
3. Animals registered jointly by two juniors may only be exhibited by one. If an animal is jointly owned by a junior and non-junior, it must be shown in the Open Division.
4. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Animals may be entered in a maximum of one class. **No cross entries between divisions**, except for 2018 calendar year calves and Pee Wee Division animals. ***NEW**
5. Animals shown in the Pee Wee divisions are eligible to be shown by another junior in a different division, provided the animal qualifies.
6. Calendar year calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in their respective class. In the event that both would qualify to advance only one animal unit can advance.
7. Division Champions from the Open Show will qualify for the Supreme Junior Futurity Championship Final. Pee Wee and Commercial champions are not eligible to compete in the Championship final.
8. Proof of registration is required for the Open and Bred & Owned classes and is to be presented at the time of registration on Thursday, November 9th. Animals without registration papers will not be eligible to show in the Open or Bred & Owned divisions. To qualify for the Bred and Owned classes, the exhibitor must provide the **registration papers of both the entry and its dam by Nov 1st 2018**. If papers are not provided, entry may be scratched and will not be allowed to enter into the corresponding Open class in the Junior Futurity show.
9. An animal may be asked to leave the show ring at the discretion of the Junior Show committee.
10. All grooming must be done by JUNIORS ONLY. Juniors may assist one another.
11. Classes will be split by age of animal if warranted after entries close at the discretion of the committee.
12. Pee Wee exhibitors are not allowed to exhibit in the Open, Bred & Owned or Commercial Divisions. Must be nine years of age to exhibit in those divisions.



Pee Wee Show – Saturday, November 11, 9:00 a.m.

Animals entered in the Pee Wee Division must be exhibited by a junior between the ages of five to eight; animals shown in the Pee Wee division are eligible to be shown by a different junior in the other divisions if they meet the criteria.

1. Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2018
2. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
3. Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st – December 31st, 2017
4. Champion & Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer
5. Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2018
6. Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
7. Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Pee Wee Division
8. Showmanship

Commercial Show – Saturday, November 11th, 10:00 a.m. (Immediately following Pee Show Completion)

Animals entered in the Commercial Division may not be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Animals may be of any percentage.

9. Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2018
10. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
11. Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st – December 31st, 2017
12. Champion & Reserve Champion Junior Female
13. Two-Year-Old Heifer: Born in 2016, with her own 2018 natural, tattooed calf at foot
14. Mature Cow: Born prior to 2016 with her own 2018, natural tattooed calf at foot
15. Champions & Reserve Champion Commercial Division

Showmanship – Saturday, November 11th, 10:00 a.m. (Immediately following Pee Show Completion)

1. This competition will be judged as a stand-alone event. The animal shown does not have to be owned by the exhibitor if participating in showmanship specific classes.
2. All junior exhibitors are eligible to compete in the showmanship competition. Those juniors who are not exhibiting cattle at Farmfair will be paired up with a breeder to use one of their animals for the competition and will compete in a separate class prior to the Showmanship championship class in order to qualify for the championship.
3. Show committee will insure members showing concurrently in the Commercial show do not miss classes.

16. Junior Showmanship - Ages 9 – 14
17. Senior Showmanship - Ages 15- 21

Open Show – Saturday, November 11th, Noon (Immediately following Commercial and Showmanship Show Completion)

Animals entered in the Open Division may not be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Papers designating **purebred** status are required as per breed association rules.

Bred & Owned Classes

Animals entered in the Bred & Owned classes must be accompanied by registration papers that show the exhibitor as the sole breeder of the animal and sole or joint owner of the entry. **Ownership must be declared at time of entry.**

25. Bred & Owned Champion & Reserve Champion Junior Female
26. Open Junior Yearling Heifer: Born from March 1st- December 31st, 2017
27. Open Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Female
28. Open Senior Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st- February 28th, 2017
29. Open Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Female
30. Bred & Owned Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2018
31. Bred & Owned Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
32. Open Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2018
33. Open Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
34. Two-Year Old Cow with Calf: Born in 2016 with her own 2018 natural, Purebred tattooed calf at foot
35. Champion & Reserve Champion Two-Year Old Female
36. Mature Cow: Born prior to 2016 with her own 2018, natural, Purebred tattooed calf at foot
