Entries made after October 1st will be accepted at the show management's discretion. Additional charge of \$50.00 per entry will apply.

Entry Fees

Cattle Panels** \$150.00 (2.5 animals per panel)
½ Cattle Panel \$75
Beef Entry\$15
Breeder's Herd\$15 (Only one entry per exhibitor)
Tie Out Fee \$15 (Includes bedding for the week)

GST Included in all entry fees. Fees are payable to Northlands which must accompany entries. All entries MUST be made through Northlands.

****Again this year, Exhibitors will buy space by the panel. Exhibitors may display their show cattle, other livestock, their operation and use as a marketing tool. Exhibitor must keep in mind space is to be kept tidy and welcoming to view.**

**** Please note show cattle must still be entered into the show at \$15.00 per head.**

Rules & Regulations

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair International. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes. Heifer calves shown on side of the Senior Champion and Reserve Champion Females will not be eligible to be shown in the heifer calf classes. The heifer calf entry fee will not be refunded.
3. Eligible Cattle: Beef Shorthorn, Lincoln Red, and Dual Purpose Shorthorn – all purebred males and females. b. Graded-up Shorthorns of registered status (87.5% 7/8 Females; 93.8% 15/16 Males). All calves shown at foot of their Dam must be registered and purebred.
4. Any Shorthorns shown at Farmfair are subject to parentage tests and/or mouthing. Tests to be supervised by the Executive Committee of the Alberta Shorthorn Association. In the event that the veterinarian determines the animal's age is incorrect, that animal will be barred from showing.
5. Shorthorn cattle born in Canada and shown by a Canadian exhibitor must carry Canadian registration papers issued by the Canadian Shorthorn Association. All foreign registration papers will be evaluated according to the Canadian Shorthorn Association's Rules of Eligibility for Registration in Canada.
6. Original registration papers must be available on all cattle.
7. If numbers of entries warrant, classes may be split.
8. Exhibitors must be Shorthorn members in good standing i.e. paid Canadian members; out of country exhibitors are exempt.
9. Only purebred champions will qualify to compete in the Alberta Supreme Show
10. Show harnesses will be mandatory to be worn by all exhibitors in the show ring
11. **NEW**-Shorthorn Plus Classes- All animals must be registered with the Canadian Shorthorn Association at a minimum of 50%
