Entries made after Oct. 1 will be accepted at the show management's discretion. Additional charges will apply.

ENTRY FEES

Conformation Class.....\$15/class*
Showmanship Class.....\$15/class**
Tie out Fee.....\$15 (includes bedding for the week)***

GST included in all entry fees. Fees are payable to Northlands which must accompany entries. All entries MUST be made through Northlands.

* Conformation Show is \$15 for every class entered

** Junior exhibitors must pay the Showmanship Fee to be entered into the competition.

*** Tie out fee does not need to be paid if junior entries are also entered into the open breed shows.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Farmfair.
2. Parent participation is not allowed with the exception of exhibitor and/or public safety. Adults will not be allowed to assist with the preparation of animals. Juniors are encouraged to assist other juniors. During registration junior exhibitors have the option to sign up to be partnered with a senior member to receive help during the competition. Exhibitors in violation of this rule will be disqualified from the show.
3. The show committee reserves the right to make decisions on any point not covered by these rules and to make corrections as necessary.
4. Show harnesses will be mandatory in the show ring.

All Breeds Conformation Show

1. Animal must be exhibited by the junior named on the entry form.
2. Animals must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or farm corporations that the junior is a member of, however the junior exhibitor must be named on the entry form.
3. Animals registered jointly by two juniors may only be exhibited by one. If an animal is jointly owned by a junior and non-junior, it must be shown in the Open Division.
4. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Animals may be entered in a maximum of one class. **No cross entries between divisions**, except for 2019 calendar year calves and Pee Wee Division animals. ***NEW**
5. Animals shown in the Pee Wee divisions are eligible to be shown by another junior in a different division, provided the animal qualifies.
6. Calendar year calves at foot are eligible to be shown as a single animal in their respective class. In the event that both would qualify to advance only one animal unit can advance.
7. Division Champions from the Open Show will qualify for the Supreme Junior Futurity Championship Final. Pee Wee and Commercial champions are not eligible to compete in the Championship final.
8. An animal may be asked to leave the show ring at the discretion of the Junior Show committee.
9. All grooming must be done by JUNIORS ONLY. Juniors may assist one another.
10. Classes will be split by age of animal if warranted after entries close at the discretion of the committee.
11. Pee Wee exhibitors are not allowed to exhibit in the Open, or Commercial Divisions. Must be nine years of age to exhibit in those divisions.

Pee Wee Show – Wednesday, November 6

Animals entered in the Pee Wee Division must be exhibited by a junior between the ages of five to eight; animals shown in the Pee Wee division are eligible to be shown by a different junior in the other divisions if they meet the criteria.

1. Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2019
2. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
3. Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st – December 31st, 2018
4. Champion & Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer
5. Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2019
6. Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
7. Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Pee Wee Division
8. Showmanship





Showmanship – Saturday, November 9th

This competition will be judged throughout the conformation classes (Commercial & Open) with age division finals prior to the Supreme Champion Class.

1. Juniors must enter and pay showmanship fee at time of entry of the show.
2. All junior exhibitors are eligible to compete in the showmanship competition. Those juniors who are not exhibiting cattle at Farmfair will be paired up with a breeder to use one of their animals for the competition and will compete in a separate class prior to the Showmanship championship class in order to qualify for the championship.
9. Junior Showmanship - Ages 9 – 14 (Enter October 1st)
10. Senior Showmanship - Ages 15- 21 (Enter October 1st)

Commercial Show – Saturday, November 9th, 9:00 a.m.

Animals entered in the Commercial Division may not be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Animals may be of any percentage.

11. Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2019
12. Champion & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf
13. Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st – December 31st, 2018
14. Champion & Reserve Champion Junior Female
15. Two-Year-Old Heifer: Born in 2017, with her own 2019 natural, tattooed calf at foot
16. Mature Cow: Born prior to 2016 with her own 2019, natural tattooed calf at foot
17. Champions & Reserve Champion Commercial Division

Open Show – Saturday, November 9th (Immediately following the Commercial show)

Animals entered in the Open Division may not be bred by the exhibitor but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the immediate family or Farm Corporation that the junior is a member of. Papers designating **purebred** status are required as per breed association rules.

18. Open Junior Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born on or after March 1, 2019
19. Open Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Heifer Calf
20. Open Senior Heifer Calf: Calendar year calf born January 1, 2019 to February 28, 2019
21. Open Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Heifer Calf
22. Open Junior Yearling Heifer: Born from March 1st- December 31st, 2018
23. Open Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Female
24. Open Senior Yearling Heifer: Born from January 1st- February 28th, 2018
25. Open Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Female
26. Open Bull Calf: Calendar year calf born in 2019
27. Open Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf
28. Two-Year Old Cow with Calf: Born in 2017 with her own 2019 natural, Purebred tattooed calf at foot
29. Champion & Reserve Champion Two-Year Old Female
30. Mature Cow: Born prior to 2016 with her own 2019, natural, Purebred tattooed calf at foot
31. Champion & Reserve Champion Mature Female

33. Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Showmanship
