General Rules

Please read directions carefully for each class (regarding size, quantity of items required, etc). Failure to follow directions may result in the item being disqualified.

All exhibitors **MUST** be the bona fide producer of their exhibits. The use of commercially produced products will result in the forfeiture of ALL prizes won by exhibitor.

Each exhibitor may only submit one entry per class.

Only Judges and designated exhibition officials are allowed in the Exhibit Area during Judging. The judge's decision is final.

The Alberta Honey Show shall use the Fair System of Judging. Only one 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place ribbon shall be awarded in each class. No ribbon will be awarded if the items in a class fail to meet a reasonable level of achievement & officials reserve the right to not display entries that fail to meet a certain level of achievement.

All entries must have official exhibition tags attached. Entry tags will be available at entry drop off.

Entries must be submitted online via the Northlands Showworks entry system on the Farmfair International website: <https://farmfairinternational.com/event/honey-show>. **The entry deadline is Monday, November 4 at 3:00 pm.**

Exhibits can be delivered to the Alberta Beekeepers Commission (ABC) office, located at: **11434 -168 Street, Suite102, Edmonton, Alberta, T5M 3T9**. Exhibits must arrive at the office **no later than** 3:00pm, Friday November 1, 2019. Exhibits may also be brought to the ABC convention being held at the Fantasyland Hotel on Monday, November 4, 2019, between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm only.

Organizers reserve the right to combine classes due to insufficient entries or divide classes with extensive entries into multiple classes. Organizers may also move an entry if it better fits in another class.

Interpretation of all rules shall be made by exhibition officials, whose decision shall be final. Should any question arise not provided for in the Rules and Regulations, the decision of the exhibition officials shall be final. The right to alter, interpret, amend, add to or cancel any of these rules, or to grant relaxation from them in individual cases is reserved to the exhibition officials.

All properties of exhibitors entered for competition shall be subject to control of the organizers, but in no case shall Northlands be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury of any nature to any such property while in Northlands possession. Organizers will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of articles, but property owners should make their own arrangements for coverage against loss, damage or injury.

Results

Entries will be on public display November 7-10, 2019 during Farmfair International. Competition results will be posted on the Farmfair International website no later than Friday, November 9 at 5 pm.





Prize Money

Prize money will be paid by cheque and mailed to the address provided upon entry. Cheques will be mailed no later than December 13, 2019. Winners should contact the show office at 780 471 7246 if they have not received their cheque by January 6, 2020.

Prize money is provided by Northlands and the Alberta Beekeepers Commission.

HONEY DIVISION

For classes 1-3, exhibitors must submit two jars per entry- one each for judging and display purposes. One jar must be free from any labelling or identifying features. Jars must be 500 g (375 ml).

Entries will be judged in accordance with the scale of points indicated below.

Uniform level of fill	5
Density (moisture content)	15
Colour	5
Freedom from crystals	15
Freedom from foreign material	15
Freedom from air bubbles	15
Uniformity of honey	5
Brightness	10
Appearance of containers	5
TOTAL	100

2. Creamed Honey
3. Flavoured Honey
4. Novel Honey Products- Candy, Baked Goods, etc
5. Honey Beverages- Mead, Honey Beer, or Honey Liqueur, minimum 330 ml





ART DIVISION

Photography

Photos must be either 5x7" or 8x10". All entries must be mounted on lightweight cardboard with a 1" border (approximate). Photos in glass, wood, or metal frames will not be accepted. A photograph cannot be entered in more than one class.

1. Youth Photography (age 17 & under): Honey or Beekeeping Photo
2. Youth Photography (age 17 & under): Bee Photo
3. Adult Photography: Honey or Beekeeping Photo
4. Adult Photography: Bee Photo

Painting & Drawing

Artwork must be framed and ready to hang. Wire is recommended.

5. Youth Artwork (age 17 & under): any scene with honey, bees, or beekeeping
6. Adult Artwork: any scene with honey, bees, or beekeeping
