General Rules

Please read directions carefully for each class (regarding size, quantity of items required, etc). Failure to follow directions may result in the item being disqualified.

All exhibitors **MUST** be the bona fide producer of their exhibits. The use of commercially produced products will result in the forfeiture of ALL prizes won by exhibitor.

Each exhibitor may only submit one entry per class.

Only Judges and designated exhibition officials are allowed in the Exhibit Area during Judging. The judge's decision is final.

The Alberta Honey Show shall use the Fair System of Judging. Only one 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place ribbon shall be awarded in each class. No ribbon will be awarded if the items in a class fail to meet a reasonable level of achievement & officials reserve the right to not display entries that fail to meet a certain level of achievement.

All entries must have official exhibition tags attached. Entry tags will be available at entry drop off.

Entries must be submitted online via the Farmfair International Showworks entry system on the Farmfair International website: [Alberta Honey Show | Farmfair International Nov 10-13, 2021](#). **The online entry deadline is Monday, November 1 at 11:59 pm.**

Exhibits can be delivered to the Alberta Beekeepers Commission (ABC) office, located at: **11434 -168 Street, Suite 102, Edmonton, Alberta, T5M 3T9**. Exhibits must arrive at the office **no later than 3:00 pm**, Tuesday November 2, 2021. **Due to COVID-19 all exhibits/products that are submitted as part of the Alberta Honey Show will NOT be returned to individuals in order to help reduce the potential of contact transmission.**

Organizers reserve the right to combine classes due to insufficient entries or divide classes with extensive entries into multiple classes. Organizers may also move an entry if it better fits in another class.

Interpretation of all rules shall be made by exhibition officials, whose decision shall be final. Should any question arise not provided for in the Rules and Regulations, the decision of the exhibition officials shall be final. The right to alter, interpret, amend, add to or cancel any of these rules, or to grant relaxation from them in individual cases is reserved to the exhibition officials.

All properties of exhibitors entered for competition shall be subject to control of the organizers, but in no case shall Northlands be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury of any nature to any such property while in Northlands possession. Organizers will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of articles, but property owners should make their own arrangements for coverage against loss, damage or injury.

Results

Entries will be on public display November 10-13, 2021, during Farmfair International. Competition results will be posted on the Farmfair International website no later than Wednesday, November 10 at 5 pm.





Prize Money

Prize money will be paid by electronic fund transfer. Winners will be contacted following the show to provide banking information.

Prize money is provided by Explore Edmonton and the Alberta Beekeepers Commission.

Entry classes

1. Liquid Honey
2. Creamed Honey
3. Flavoured Honey
4. Hive Products - Personal Care: lip balm, body butter, etc.
5. Hive Products – Innovation: bees wax wraps, fire starters, furniture polish etc.

For classes 1-3, exhibitors must submit **two jars per entry- ONE free from any labelling or identifying features for judging purposes, and ONE branded version (if available) for display purposes at the Farmfair event.** Jars must be 500 g (375 ml). For classes 4 - 5, only one product is required.





Judging Scale - Classes 1 to 3

For classes 1-3, entries will be judged in accordance with the scale of points as indicated below:

Flavour and aroma	10
Uniform level of fill	5
Density (moisture content)	15
Colour	5
Freedom from crystals	15
Freedom from foreign material	15
Freedom from air bubbles	15
Uniformity of honey	5
Brightness	10
Appearance of containers	5
TOTAL	100

Judging Scale - Classes 4 to 5

For classes 4-5 entries will be judged in accordance with the scale of points as indicated below:

Creativity	20
Innovation	20
Branding	20
Scent	20
Texture	20
